

Terry McWilliams of Greenfield, Indiana, father of the Stupid Tube, is one of very few anglers to climb through the amateur ranks and to come just shy of taking home the bragging rights of fishing world champion. Terry, grandfather of 5, is a legend amongst Indiana bass anglers having finished 4th in the Bassmaster Classic in 2007 after qualifying through the BASS Nation amateur ranks. Terry is most notable for bringing the limelight to a technique he has all but perfected, the Stupid Tube. He followed up his Classic performance nearly after with a trip to the FLW All-American where he had a top 10 finish as well. Terry has been a part of numerous State Teams and has competed at almost every level of competition. Terry has years of experience guiding for smallmouth bass on the White River which has allowed him to hone in his skills where he has recently displayed in the FLW BFL Michigan Division finishing third in points for the year of 2016.
